“The only non-Napa label to make this list, Hidden Ridge Vineyard lies between Mt. Hood and Diamond Mtn. in the Mayacamas range on the Napa and Sonoma border. **Marco DiGiulio is the winemaker** working with 55 acres planted in 21 blocks, all on rugged terrain and steep slopes. *‘You feel like you’re falling off the end of the earth,’* says DiGiulio about the drive in.

Owners Lynn Hofacket and Casidy ward planted the vineyard over the past decade. *‘It’s one of those vineyards that you just have to see to believe,’* says DiGiulio.”

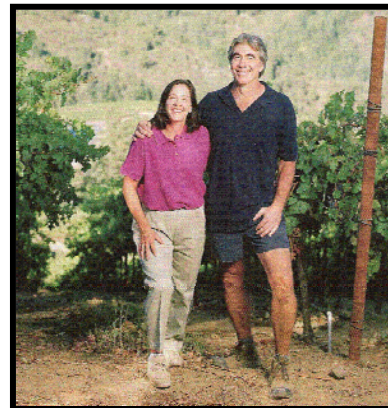
