Vineyard Location: Between Santa Rosa and St. Helena in the Mayacama Mountains separating Sonoma and Napa Counties. The vineyard's closest neighbors are Pride Mountain Winery and Paloma Vineyards.

Size: 165 acres with 55 acres planted in 21 blocks.

Cabernet Sauvignon Clones: 4, 337, 7 and 169

Unique features:

- >> Rugged, terraced blocks planted with inside and outside rows
- >> Slopes as steep as 55%
- >> VSP trellis system modified to allow for afternoon shading
- >> Terraces follow the mountain for optimum orientation
- >> Hand-harvested and delivered to winery with all-terrain vehicles.
- >> Vineyard developed from start to finish by owners, who bought the iron, trained the employees and served as general contractor and day-to-day management.
